

## 38th Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade

The Ancient Order of Hibernians along with their families, friends, and supporting businesses, will celebrate their **25th anniversary** Saturday, March 16th, 2024, with St. Joseph's biggest and best St. Patrick's Day Parade ever! Join Grand Marshals, **The Delaney Family**, as we march in celebration of our Irish heritage while raising money for Second Harvest Food Bank. Just follow a few simple rules below, return the attached form with payment and meet us on Noyes Boulevard at 10:30 am **March 16th**. The parade starts at NOON traveling down Frederick Avenue to Francis Street, proceeding on Francis Street turning left at 7<sup>th</sup> street and then left again on Felix Street proceeding to finish under the arches on Felix Street and disbanding at 8<sup>th</sup> and Felix in front of Room 108. The Arches on Felix Street have a height restriction of 16 feet; please don't get stuck under them!

## **A Few Simple Rules**

- ✓ \$75 Entry fee. Our costs have gone up but still inexpensive family fun!
- ✓ Entries should have an Irish theme! Music must be of an IRISH NATURE !
- ✓ Objects, i.e. candy, beads, etc., MAY NOT BE THROWN from any entry. On the other hand, distributing while walking is acceptable.
- ✓ Alcohol is not permitted on or with any entry.
- ✓ The parade committee will assign each entry a spot the day of the parade and we reserve the right to refuse any entry. Irish families will line up in the front of the parade line, followed by the rest of the entries.
- ✓ Send completed entry form with payment to: Deadline for entries is March 7<sup>th</sup>.
